Dear Parents and Carers,

What an amazing week of enrichment in school!

Ahead of British Science Week later this month and to help us celebrate, we invited in the Science Boffins to run some fantastic workshops with our children. We kicked off this morning with an incredible whole-school assembly by 'Boffin Jayne' filled with hydrogen peroxide, potassium iodine and exothermic reactions! The teachers did have to prod a baby's nappy though! Year 5 and 6 classes then had the chance to explore states of matter further through workshops and Year 3 and 4 were amazed by the plasma balls and playful polymers they looked it in their workshops! 
